1. Call to order

2. Welcome and Introductions

3. Approval of Agenda

6. Student Leaders Update

The SRC representative was unable to attend.

7. Principal's Report

- a. January Monthly Moments – from SRC – out to all parents. Update on what has been happening at school.
- b. New cafeteria rules in all schools – starting in September Provincial school plan program – govt update – goal: affordable, healthy school lunches 5 days per week, prices 6.50-8. Vegetarian option included and a protein option. Looking into payment plan options for families. Subsidies can be available for some children in need so they can have a prepaid card and go to the cafeteria.
- c. Parent concern – delayed green light at intersection at main entrance on Cliffe – walk light should go first to increase student safety. Raised idea of cross walk indicator in main Leo Hayes parking lot to indicate where students cross to the school sidewalk. Painted so is visible with no snow, but not visible under snow. Safety concern.
- d. School plan updates – engagement, safety, attendance – anti vaping programs – train the trainers – starting semester 2 – Leo Hayes students will go into grade 6 programs to teach about dangers of vaping. Attendance – full time teacher working with all ESS teams, focused on attendance. Focused on kids skipping class but staying at school. Where biggest impact can be made.
- e. New washrooms upstairs completed. Initially 50/50 feedback, now kids love it – privacy.
- f. PBIS lessons – executive functioning skills – goal for semester 2– choosing one a month, such as binder organization, study skills etc. Teachers making videos and sharing with students.
- g. Solo Chicken Productions – inclusionary drama club. Anyone can join. Everyone is welcome. Had one session so far. Costs for facilitators to come in. Using PSSC/Best Buddies funding. They will be coming in weekly on Wednesdays and there will be a performance in the future.

8. New Business

Provincial Education Plan Consultations – the sessions focused more on the younger students, daycare to kindergarten and elementary. Not much for high school levels.
